ABSTRACT

This research is purposely done to determine whether camera phone abuse can occur among FTMSK societies. It is also to determine whether camera phone abuse may cause information theft, privacy issues and violation the law. In addition, this research also makes a comparison between students and lecturers. Besides, the researcher will propose an ethical guideline on proper usage of camera phone.
