Introduction

Plagiarism can be viewed as a serious illness spread in students' attitude nowadays. This culture is a serious crime in academic world that could involve a disciplinary action to university students. First, we will clarify the meaning. Plagiarism is literally a thief who took the work or ideas of others and claimed it is theirs. This is done without the owner's permission. As the ease of retrieving information from the internet, instead of referring to a book, university students usually blindly take the available information from their search and directly use it. Since this method is more users friendly and enhances the simplicity of 'copy and paste' process from the original document, this way is more preferable while completing their assignment

Contrary to it, copyright is not something new. The perceptions towards hearing the word have connected it to the word plagiarism. But when it comes to getting new information and ideas, people tend to forget about copyright. This usually happened among university students or when someone is doing a research, in which, most of them copy from a book or websites entirely or partially and didn't cite the sources properly. This has made their research or assignments looks like it is plagiarized from others. Copying others ideas, works, or article itself proves that it is a bad attitude. As information and technology develops, there is a higher chance of students copying without acknowledge the rightful person's works. This might be due to no specific system of registration for copyright in Malaysia.

The copyright protection in Malaysia is governed by the Copyright Act 1987 and it is an exclusive right given to the owner of a copyright for a specific period (Myipo.gov.my, 2015). The copyright act came into force on 1 December 1987 and since then, various updates and amendments were made until the latest one is Copyright (Amendment) Act 2012.

Factors Influencing Plagiarism

There are several factors that influence plagiarism among the students such as to get a better grade, ineffective time management, task pressure and personal values. The biggest factor for students cheating is to increase their grade and have a much better results. The lacks of confident have turned them into a cheater. They tend to use other's ideas and words rather than their own words. Normally, students want to succeed faster by using easier way with minimal effort of learning. As a shortcut, they tend to copy and paste others' works and claiming those works are theirs. Students also think that to be a successful student they need to focus on getting the best results for their final examination rather than skills they learn while studying in university to be practiced during their job life.



Another factor is student also has deficient planning of their time table properly. This might happened due to conducting simultaneous tasks such as working a part time job during ample time and at the same time, having class workloads. The same student might also involve actively in clubs and societies which resulting them for not having enough time to complete their assignments properly before submitting them.

Besides that, having task pressure in achieving a high standard is one of the reasons that plagiarism happen among student. Copying happen when the tasks given by the lecturer are very difficult to be accomplished based on low level of related knowledge in the field of study. As student cannot complete their task according to the requirements needed by the lecturer, they easily can duplicate other person's works through internet or by getting a copy of the assignment from their seniors that is already completed.

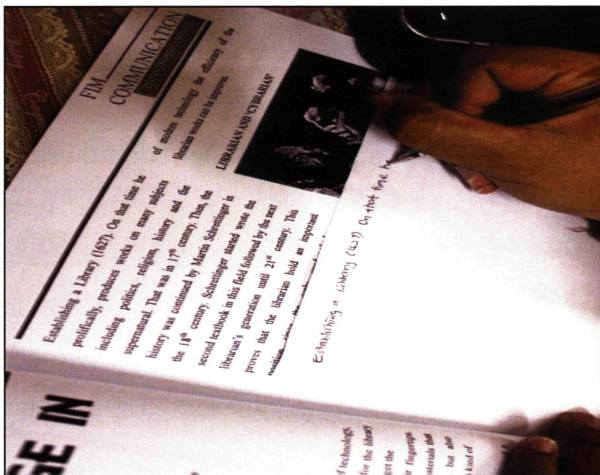
Effects from Plagiarism

Most of students did not aware that plagiarism was a threat to academic integrity. Majority of student that involved in plagiarism did not give any citation or credits to the person's effort and which sources they gathered the information. In order to acquaint plagiarism among student, universities warn the students they will receive zero grade or deduction in marks for their assignment. From here, they can learn using proper citation for each information that they are copying from either the internet or book to reduce plagiarism.

If the student takes no action to avoid from repeating plagiarism, university can take action of expulsion the student from the university. This is a very serious consequence from plagiarisms. As a result of student's suspension from the university, they got bad records that lead to problem of continuing studying in other university or getting a job, plus an oblique perception from community point of view.

Overcome Plagiarism Activities

University can develop strategic plans to reduce plagiarism. One of the strategy is by offering a training session for students to use their fresh ideas to make their own sentences. These sessions are to teach and guide students to make their own arguments based on several reference materials given. As the training sessions will be open to all students, each student is encouraged to attend attentively with the intention to improve their writing skills. In order to make it work, the university can appoint an experienced lecturer that expert in writing to help students on creating their own article, report, and others. Another way, student should learn to cite their references. Students must understand the need, practice and skill to do a proper citation to avoid plagiarism especially when using internet sources as reference.



Copyright

Copyright Act starts before 1983 where intellectual property rights (IPR) in Malaysia was administered by Pejabat Cap Dagangan dan Jamin Hak. Various changes had been made on the office name since then and later the acronym became MyIPO. The objectives of this corporation is clear where the law will help to strengthen and providing a comprehensive yet user friendly information while promoting public awareness programme and providing advisory services on intellectual property. Several conditions are taken into consideration to spontaneously protecting the work. The conditions are, first, there are adequate effort has been anticipated to make the work original. Second, the work has been written down, recorded or reduced to a material form and finally, the author is qualified or author's work is first published in Malaysia.

Copyright protects several works which includes literary, musical, artistic works, films, sound recordings, broadcast and derivative works. These works will be protected irrespective to their quality and purpose for which they are created. Owner of copyright is the author which includes writer, composer, maker of the work and others.

However, copyright protections are limited only on expression and not ideas, procedures, and methods of operation. Each types of works have different lasting period. However generally, all works have up to fifty years of copyright durations. Copyright owners have the exclusive rights to control the reproduction of the works; the performing, showing, communication or playing to the public; the distribution of copies by sales and the commercial rental to the public to works that are copied partly or wholly.

It also act as a proof for the person whom claims that his/her works had been infringed. Copyright broadcasts get their exclusive rights to control the recording, the reproduction, and the rebroadcasting of the whole or several part of the broadcast. If the show is meant for public, admission fee is charged. The television broadcast copyright includes the right to control the taking of still photographs from the broadcast. There is also moral rights. Moral rights are basically, rights to oppose changes in the copyright that could harm the reputation of the creator.

Copyright Infringement

Copyright infringement is a work infringed when a person is not being the owner of the copyright and without license from the owner of the copyright. Copyright infringement includes such a way of reproduces in any material form, performs, play or distribute to the public for the whole or a part of the work; imports any article for financial gaining; make sales out of infringed copies; sells, trade or offers for sale of any infringing copy; distributes infringing copies; possesses for private or domestic use of any infringing copy; removes or alters any electronic rights management information without authority consents. The penalties imposed on a guilty infringer includes fines and imprisonment. These copyright infringement can be found more exercisable through social media or internet where the information available could be easily copied to one's smart devices.

Conclusion

In a nutshell, plagiarism exists in academic institution and students now aware that plagiarism is a bad activity that they need to follow the university guideline to avoid plagiarism. Lecturers should constantly remind students about plagiarism to control and solve this academic problem. Against plagiarism, copyright is a method to prohibit any immoral activity that breached others' ideas, works or privacy as there are penalties and actions taken for those who violate the Copyright Act. That is why it is important for students, public or any higher learning institution to know and exposed to the plagiarism and copyright atmosphere.

Ethiopia still follows a traditional calendar that is seven years behind the rest of the world.

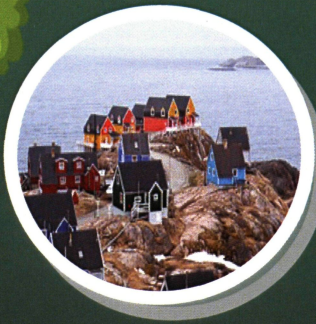

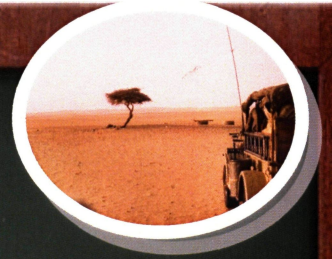

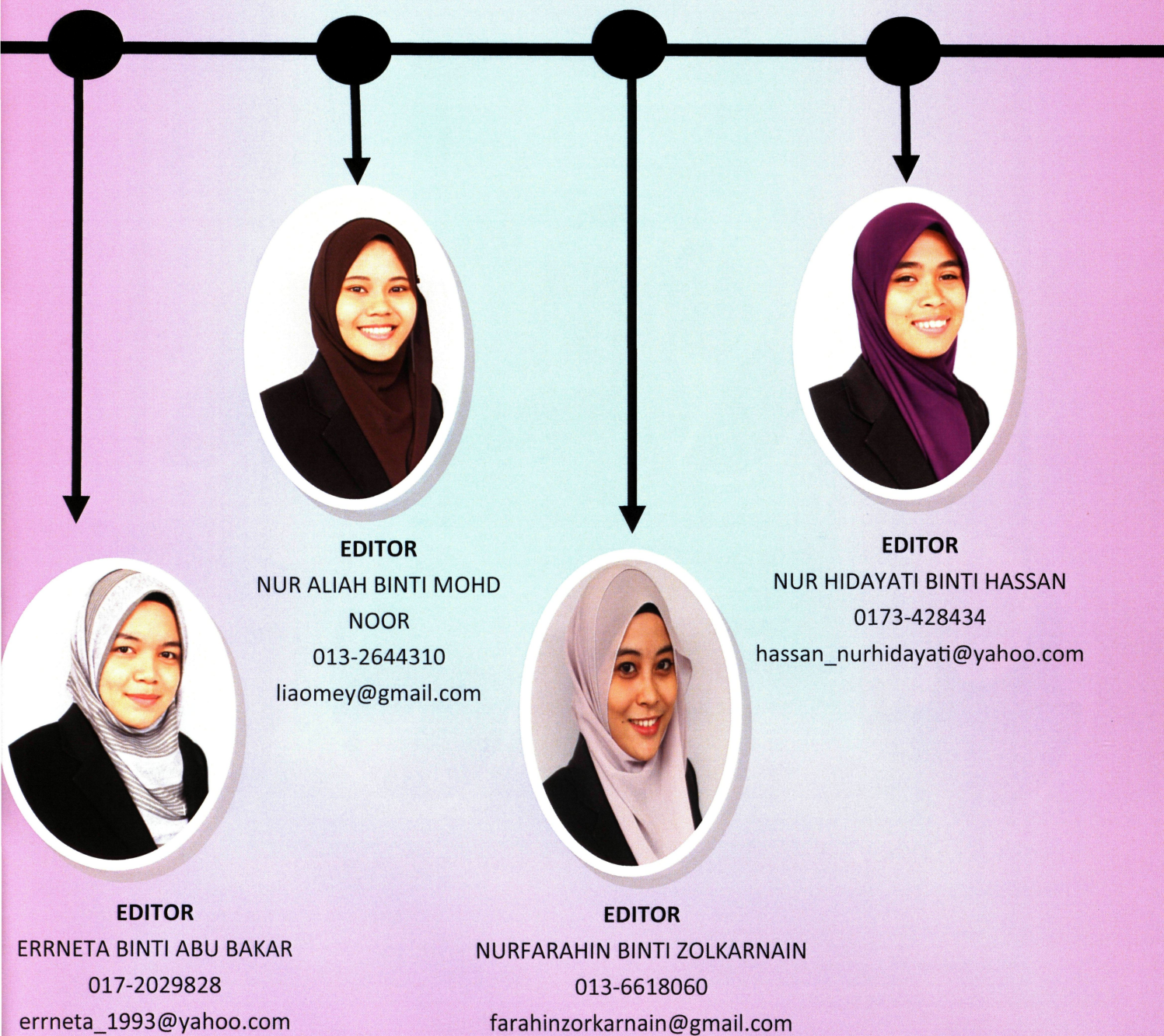

TYPE OF CONTRIBUTIONS

AUTHOR GUIDELINES

1. Content

We prefer FIM COMMUNICATION articles that are 750 - 1500 words in. They should be in English or Bahasa Melayu.

Articles **should not have been published previously in another magazine or journal**, nor been available in a **final version on a publicly available web site**.

2. Matters of style

- Text should be in Microsoft Word or rtf format.
- Images may be in gif, or jpeg formats. Images can be handled several ways — as in-lines or as linked files. They normally should be no more than 700 pixels in width.

- The font type required is Arial, 11pt.

3. Mechanics of submission

While we often receive completed manuscripts, we would prefer that you contact the editors at tintaafpm1@gmail.com before you finish writing so that we can determine whether the topic, style, and approach are appropriate for FIM COMMUNICATION. We accept only electronic submissions. For any correspondence, keep in mind that the tinta_editor@gmail.com email address receives a large amount of spam and email to that address is filtered. Prepare your message with a proper subject line, body and signature block.

- Articles can be sent to tintaafpm1@gmail.com as email attachments. Please include "FIM COMMUNICATION Article Submission" in the message subject line.

Each author will be asked to submit a brief (50 - 100 word) biographical sketch along with his or her manuscript. Please contact the editors for details upon acceptance of your article.

4. Editorial Process

- Upon acceptance, articles are put on the magazine's production schedule for two months that is mutually acceptable to the authors and editors.
- FIM COMMUNICATION editors will read your submission and return it with suggested changes or comments.
- After the authors and editors have agreed on a final draft, the revised text will be formatted in doc or pdf by FIM COMMUNICATION staff.
- Authors will have a specified length of time to request final corrections or minor changes prior to the release of the magazine to the public.
- Once the issue has been released, only vital corrections or changes will be made to the file. These changes will be noted and dated at the end of the file.

FIM COMMUNICATION requires non-exclusive permission to disseminate and make the material available. Author(s) are responsible for clearing any rights prior to submitting materials to us.
