Pada 29 Januari 2005 yang lalu, Pusat Pemikiran Dan Kefahaman Islam (CITU), UiTM Kampus Samarahan telah menganjurkan Seminar Ekonomi dan Kewangan Islam di Dewan Kuliah 2 , UiTM Kampus Samarahan. Seminar ini telah dirasmikan oleh Yang Berbahagia Prof Dr Abdul Rahman Deen, Pengarah UiTM Kampus Samarahan. Para peserta terdiri daripada kakitangan Hal Ehwal Akademik dan Pentadbiran dan juga para pelajar peringkat Diploma dan Ijazah Sarjana Muda Fakulti Pengurusan Perniagaan dan Perakaunan.

Objektif seminar ini adalah untuk memberi kefahaman yang tepat mengenai operasi perbankan Islam, menjelaskan perlaksanaan produk perbankan yang diharuskan dalam Islam dan

Pada 29 November – 1 Disember 2004 Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) Sarawak telah mengadakan Retreat Perancangan Strategik UiTM Sarawak 2004 yang telah berlangsung di Santubong Resort Kuching. Retreat ini adalah bertujuan untuk mencipta "BluePrint" bagi UiTM Sarawak ke arah mencapai status Universiti Bertaraf Dunia. Pada hari pertama Retreat, tiga "Keynote Addresses" telah disampaikan iaitu:

1. "Hala Tuju Universiti Bertaraf Dunia" yang disampaikan oleh Timbalan Naib Canselor (Akademik), Y.Bhg Dato' Prof. Ir. Dr Sahol Abdul Hamid.
2. "Cabaran Universiti Bertaraf Dunia" yang disampaikan oleh Timbalan Naib Canselor (Pembangunan dan Penyelidikan), Y.Bhg Dato' Prof. Dr. Abdul Halim Mohd. Nawawi, dan
3. "Perlaksanaan Perancangan Strategik" yang disampaikan oleh Prof. Madya Dr. Ismail Rahmat, Timbalan Ketua Pusat Perancangan Strategik UiTM.

Ini telah disusuli dengan perbincangan dalam kumpulan yang telah dibahagikan kepada enam (6) sesi perbincangan iaitu:

Retreat Perancangan Strategik UiTM Sarawak 2004 telah dirasmikan oleh Timbalan Naib Canselor (Akademik), Y.Bhg Dato' Prof Ir. Dr Sahol Abdul Hamid. Antara lain Y.Bhg Dato' TNC (Akademik) mengingatkan untuk menjadi sebuah universiti bertaraf dunia, warga UiTM Sarawak mestilah mempunyai "Mindset" yang dikehendaki, serta mempunyai keyakinan yang tinggi ke arah merealisasikan aspirasi ini. # Bengkel Tangani Stres Dan Khidmat Pelanggan Berkualiti

Pada 6 Januari, 2005 yang lalu, satu bengkel Pengurusan Pelanggan telah dianjurkan oleh Jawatankuasa Pengurusan Pelanggan di Penview Inn, Kuching. Ianya disertai oleh sekumpulan staff UiTM Sarawak yang terlibat di dalam kegiatan atau tugas-tugas khidmat pelanggan di kampus. Bengkel tersebut dikendalikan oleh En. Muhamad Halil dari HKN Consult Sdn. Bhd. Bengkel tersebut bertajuk "Pengurusan Stres & Aspek Perkhidmatan Pelanggan Berkualiti."

Di antara maklumat penting yang dapat disimpulkan dari bengkel tersebut adalah pentingnya menangani stres dengan baik bagi memastikan penyediaan khidmat pelanggan yang baik. Perbincangan bengkel turut menyimpulkan punca-punca stres termasuk faktor-faktor seperti menjelang tarikh akhir sesuatu tugas, hubungan dengan rakan sekerja, jumlah tugas, dan sebagainya. Hasil perbincangan kumpulan, peserta turut membentang cara-cara menangani faktor-faktor tersebut di bahagian masing-masing. Antara cadangan bagi menangani stres (dari aspek peribadi dan kumpulan) termasuk perancangan awal, kesegaran fizikal dengan senaman dan bersukan, ketenangan melalui aktiviti kerohanian, keperihatinan terhadap rakan sekerja dengan bekerjasama, dan sebagainya.

Bagi aspek pengurusan pelanggan berkualiti, peserta juga turut ditayangkan sebuah video yang membayangkan kemungkinan kesan yang berlaku jika seseorang pelanggan tidak dilayan dengan memuaskan. Kesan negatif dari satu pengalaman negatif seorang pelanggan boleh mempengaruhi imej organisasi dengan mendalam, berbandingkan banyak pengalaman positif pelanggan-pelanggan. Oleh itu staff harus menyediakan khidmat pelanggan sebaik mungkin, bagi mengelak atau mengurangkan

kemungkinan keadaan seperti itu berlaku. Keperihatinan, kecekapan, ketulusan serta kesediaan ingin membantu, adalah penting dalam menyediakan khidmat yang baik di samping aspek-aspek seperti profesionalisma, tanggungjawab, dan sebagainya. Adalah diharapkan peserta bengkel telah mendapat manfaat perbincangan, pendedahan melalui program tersebut, serta ilham dan semangat bagi menyediakan khidmat cemerlang. Dengan itu khidmat pelanggan yang baik dapat disediakan kepada pelanggan-pelanggan kita iaitu mana-mana pihak yang berurusan dengan kita.

Tahniah diucapkan kepada pengelola atas kejayaan menjanjurkan bengkel tersebut, terutamanya kepada Pn. Siniter Saba, Pn. Susana William, Pn. Noor Shima Antoni, Cik Dayang Nazari, serta Pof. Madya Pauline Achan.

# Taklimat Kenaikan Pangkat

Pada Januari 14, 2005 yang lalu, TNC Akademik, Dato' Prof Ir Sahol Hamid Abu Bakar telah menyampaikan taklimat tentang kenaikan pangkat. Menurut beliau, antara syarat-syarat yang diperlukan untuk melayakkan diri bagi kenaikan pangkat ialah:

1. disahkan dalam perkhidmatan;
2. memiliki kelayakan ijazah sarjana dalam bidang berkaitan yang diiktiraf oleh kerajaan daripada institusi-institusi pengajian tinggi tempatan atau kelayakan yang setaraf dengannya (untuk Gred DM 41 ke DM 46);
3. mencapai tahap kecemerlangan akademik yang istimewa mutunya dan syarat-syarat lain yang munasabah yang ditetapkan oleh Lembaga Pengarah UiTM (untuk Gred DM 41 ke DM 46, Gred DU/DM45/46 ke DU/DM52 dan Gred DU/DM 52 ke DU/DM 54 (Profesor Madya);

atau

mencapai tahap kecemerlangan akademik yang terke muka mutunya dan syarat-syarat lain yang munasabah yang ditetapkan oleh Lembaga Pengarah UiTM (untuk Gred DU/DM 54 ke Gred Khas C (Profesor Gred VK7);

4. lulus semua penilaian tahap kecekapan yang ditetapkan; dan
5. diperakuan oleh ketua perkhidmatan.

Di samping itu, terdapat beberapa prinsip umum yang diberi pemberat mengikut gred jawatan sebagai kriteria penilaian bagi tujuan kenaikan pangkat:

1. Pengajaran dan Penyeliaan
2. Penyelidikan dan Penerbitan
3. Perundingan dan/atau Kepakaran
4. Persidangan
5. Khidmat universiti/masyarakat
6. Sanjungan dan anugerah akademik
7. Kepimpinan dan kualiti peribadi

Pameran Rekacipta, Innovasi dan Rekabentuk 2004 telah diadakan di perkarangan pusat pelajar kampus Samarahan pada 31 Januari 2005 yang lalu.

Ia dianjurkan oleh Unit Penyelidikan, Pembangunan & Pengkomersilan (URDC) Kampus Samarahan dengan kerjasama Institut Penyelidikan, Pembangunan & Pengkomersilan (IRDC), UiTM, Shah Alam

Seramai tujuh orang wakil dari kampus utama Shah Alam bersama-sama bahan-bahan pameran mereka yang memenangi pertandingan Rekacipta, Innovasi dan Rekabentuk 2004 telah berada di kampus kita atas jemputan Pengarah Kampus Profesor Dr Abdul Rahman Deen.

## Spelling Bee Contest

It was a challenge of linguistic competence for six lecturers from the Language Department and two from the Faculty of Business Studies when they were invited to be the judges for the Spelling Bee Competition organized by UNITAR Sarawak Regional Centre on 26 and 27 February 2005 recently.



5S, under the new leadership of Miss Angel Helen, visited National Productivity Corporation (NPC) on February 5, 2005. There were 35 of us, comprising both lecturers and administration staff. This benchmarking visit was in line with UiTM's effort to continuously improve 5S practices in the work place. 5S is a Japanese acronym for SEIRI, SEITON, SEISO, SEIKETSU, and SHITSUKE. SEIRI means the sorting out and discarding of unnecessary items in the workplace; SEITON means arranging necessary items in good order so that they can easily be selected for use

while SEISO means to clean the workplace completely so that there is no dust on floors, machines or equipment. SEIKETSU is to maintain the workplace so that it is productive and comfortable by repeating the SEIRI-SEISO-SEITON steps. SHITSUKE is to train people to follow good work habits and to strictly follow workplace rules.

One of the consultants at NPC, Puan Nor Robaayah Mohd Noor, gave us a talk on 5S best practices at work place. We were then brought around to visit the offices on ground and first floor where 5S was being practised. It was an eye-opener for us as the offices were clean with clear labeling. Everything was in its place (when not in use).

Finally we were ushered back to the library. Before we bade farewell, tokens of appreciation were exchanged. It was indeed a fruitful benchmarking visit.

# Innovative Thinking

What is meant by the expression "innovative thinking"? Being innovative is typically considered to be in the realm of creating and devising new ideas. But what makes them new? Perhaps more to the point - for whom are they new? And where do these ideas come from - what is their source? Let's attempt to address these questions.

The term "innovation" is derived from the Latin "novare", meaning "to renew". As was stated above, innovation is often associated with something that is new, but the original meaning of the word is "renew". Perhaps this captures the notion that there are probably very few genuine ideas in the world, but simply different ways of reworking, reshaping and combining existing ideas, so that they become renewed. They are regarded as being new because they have not occurred to those who become aware of them. However, every innovation is built from a foundation of existing ideas. New ideas do not emerge from nowhere. What makes them seem new is that they are seen in a different light or, they are observed differently. This is why you might occasionally have heard someone say "Why didn't I think of that?", recognising that they were quite capable of having generated the thought(s) someone else did.

This notion of renewing is captured in some approaches to effective communication, which includes teaching, sports coaching and psychotherapy. The underlying premise is that the source of new ideas is "the answer within". By this is meant that the solution to a difficulty does not come from a source external to the person (observer) faced with the difficulty. Through skilful conversation a teacher, a therapist or a coach can facilitate different, and more productive ways, of viewing the difficulty, and so take the person down a different path in their thinking, one that throws up ideas they were not utilising already, but did not access in their old ways of thinking. Within their thinking capability most people have the ideas that contain solutions, but they simply haven't observed things differently to gain access to these ideas.

A skilful conversationalist can be a very resourceful servant in facilitating different ways of observing, ways that reveal different, and seemingly new, ways of thinking about a circumstance. The different thinking derives from different ways of perceiving, which can be expressed as follows:

"Making things anew is not my style. Seeing things anew - from an odd angle, in an unexpected light, coloured differently - is more to my liking." .... Robert Dessaix

The essence of innovative thinking is about seeing things differently, which results from taking a fresh look at a situation. It is the different way of looking at things that generates new ideas, these ideas being the expression of a different

perspective. An idea is a conception, a way of conceiving and perceiving the world. Different ideas themselves may also generate novel perspectives. New possibilities appear, like an unveiling of something that was always there but could not be seen from another vantage point. From this different perspective a range of different, and more productive and constructive, strategies and courses of action become apparent.

Different ways of thinking, and the generation of different and "new" ideas are produced from different ways of being and observing. Personal change and more resourceful and innovative thinking go hand in glove. Different ideas produce different practices, and continually being in the realm of generating different ideas provides the foundation for the development of flexibility in dealing with the ever-changing circumstances that repeatedly confront organisational leaders. Organisational transformation is about putting new ideas into practice, and new practices are about different ways of being.

Probably one of the most significant learning challenges facing leaders can be expressed in the following question. "How can they become different observers, aware not only of their own observing, but also how they can shift from habitual ways of observing which may not serve them or their organisations sufficiently to deal with the vicissitudes of the business world?"
