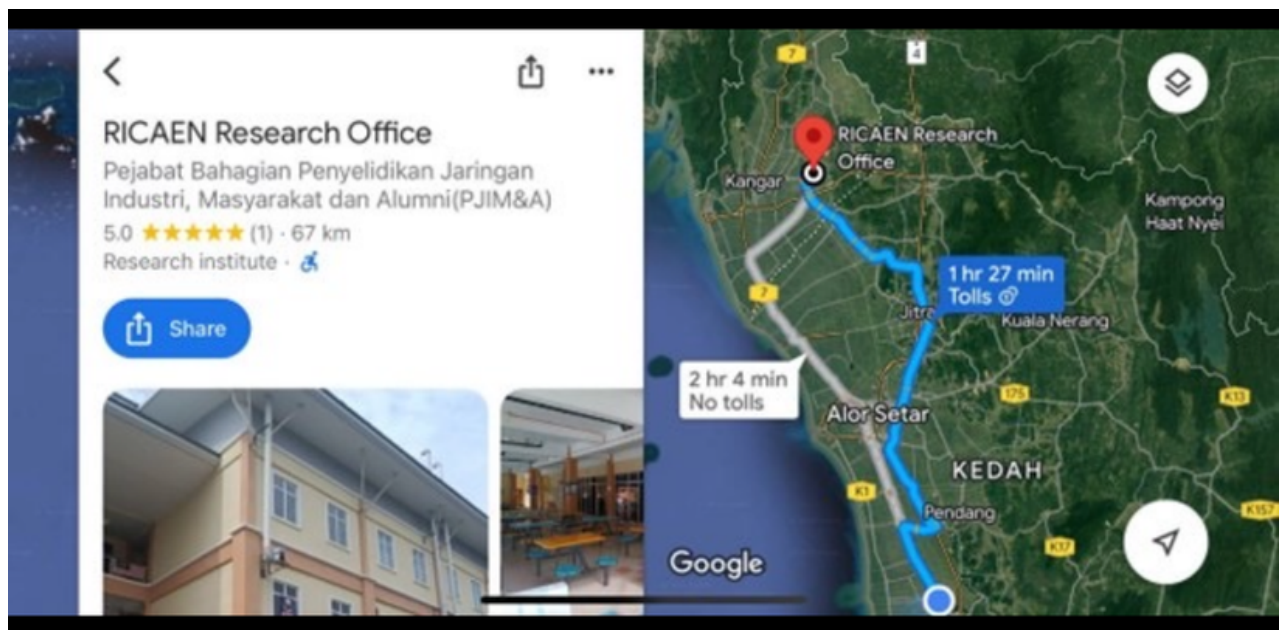


Figure 2: Direction from my house
