Next, the audience was presented with a corporate video by UiTM, followed by a Mayflax Sdn. Bhd. corporate video. The program ended at 1 p.m. with a corporate gift exchange between UiTM and Mayflax Sdn. Bhd.

Mayflax is the first group purchasing organisation in the private sector in Malaysia. The company buys products in bulk from all the pharmaceutical manufacturers, and customers get the products at affordable prices. Mayflax's mission is to foster the growth and success of healthcare professionals by providing them with access to a wide range of high-quality pharmaceutical products at affordable prices.

Mayflax has developed a service called PillPlan, which involves the personalisation and pre-sorting of long-term medications into pouches according to patients' consumption times. This service aims to improve medication adherence and reduce the risk of hospitalisation due to non-compliance with chronic illnesses. UiTM is a distinguished institution of higher learning that seeks to contribute to the advancement of knowledge and societal well-being through education, research, and community engagement.

This relationship represents a significant milestone in both parties' effort to contribute to the advancement of knowledge and societal well-being through education, research, and community engagement.
