### CHAPTER 1

# 1.1 Definition of Maintenance.

Building maintenance is defined as "work undertaken in order to keep, restore or improve every facility, i.e. every part of a building, its services and surrounds, to a currently accepted standards and to sustain the utility and value of the facility ".[R & D Bulletin, HMSO, 1972]

#### BS 3811 defines maintenance as :

" the combination of all technical and associated administrative actions intended to retain an item in, or restore it to, a state which it can perform its required condition ". [BS 3811, 1984]

The definitions indicate two broad strategies for maintenance:

- i. the retain of a building and it facilities such as painting, cleaning etc.
- ii. the restoration or repair of a building part or its facilities and this may include upgrading and replacement.

For maintenance there are two main types of standards:

### i. quality standards.

An acceptable quality of maintenance work must be controlled by a supervisor or a technical staff. Any fault of workmanship can be the cause of complaint. The quality standards includes a high quality of standard of materials and
