"Convocation" is used on college and university campuses worldwide to refer to a variety of ceremonies. "The act or process of gathering a group of people to a meeting" is convocation. It usually refers to a formal college or university assembly.

Convocation ceremonies mark the day graduates graduate from post-secondary colleges and universities. These highly ritualised events represent academic success.

University convocation is usually a bi-annual celebration where graduating students receive their academic hoods and cross the stage to receive their degrees in front of their university's president, provost, faculty members and family and friends in the audience. University convocation celebrates students' culmination of their academic journey with a particular institutions.
