

96TH UiTM CONVOCAATION

The 96th Convocation Ceremony was presided over by Ybhg. Tan Sri Dato Zarinah Anwar, Pro-Chancellor of UiTM, and took place in the Jubilee Hall on the Samarahan Campus. This session recognized 279 graduates from the Faculty of Accountancy, Faculty of Administrative Science and Policy Studies, Faculty of Hotel and Tourism Management, and Faculty of Information Management. Following that, Ybhg. Tan Sri Dato Zarinah Anwar, the Pro-Chancellor of UiTM, resumed the 96th Convocation Ceremony, session 2, in which 315 graduates from the Faculty of Business Management were honored.



The 96th UiTM Convocation ceremony of the UiTM Sarawak branch was further animated by the presence of the Pesta Konvoquesyen (PESKO), which took place in the parking lot of the student administrative center building on the Samarahan campus. Visitors will find that a wide variety of booths, including those offering food and beverages, flower bouquets, and other items, have been set up and are open for visitors.
