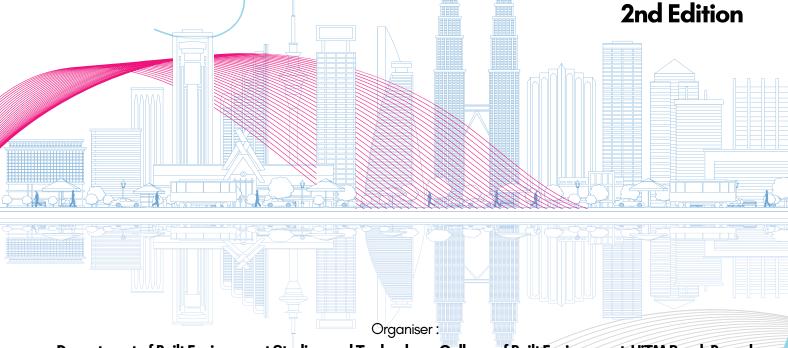

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


Figure 1: Image of Rebung's design process




Figure 2: Image of Rebung's layout and sectional view
