Jabatan Penyiaran Negeri Perlis is also known as Radio Televisyen Malaysia (RTM) Perlis or PerlisFM. It is located at Persiaran Tuanku Syed Putra, in a very strategic place in Kangar. RTM operates under Ministry of Communications. Perlis FM is a radio station owned and operated by Radio Televisyen Malaysia, the public national radio network. It is one out of 34 radio station under RTM.

The operation hours of RTM Perlis is from 6a.m. to 12a.m. for radio broadcast. The office of RTM Perlis operates from 8a.m. to 5p.m..



BACKGROUND OF RTM PERLIS

- In early 1970's Perlis and Kedah's listener only listen to broadcast from Penang. Unfortunately, they do face reception issues like distance and interference. They come out with a solution to install a NFC radio transmitter in Padang Pauh.
- On 1st July 1972, it then began broadcasting from Padang Pauh, running 18 hours daily. After that, Padang Pauh also serve as main transmitter for Radio Alor Setar in 1978.
- AM transmitter operations ceased after 18 years of service. Then, the establishment of a studio for Radio 3 Kangar, inaugurated by the Perlis Chief Minister the radio broadcast changed to FM.
- RTM decide to rent a space in KWSP building in Kangar for daily operation to have a better space for Radio 3 Kangar, it was officially opened on 11th August 1992.
- On the 55th anniversary of RTM, Radio 3 Kangar has transform the name to Radio Malaysia Perlis. It operates as Radio Malaysia Perlis for 4 years, then change to PerlisFM on 59th anniversary of RTM.
- Perlisfm then faced another new phase when they finally have their own complex in 2019. Perlisfm start
 operate in the new complex on 25th November 2019. It is equipped with modern facilities for better
 broadcasting capabilities. Till today, Perlisfm still operate in the complex and there were always
 advancement of equipments and facilities accordance with the circulation of time.
