COMPANY BACKGROUND

Amanah Saham Nasional Berhad, also known as ASNB, is a fully-owned division of Permodalan Nasional Berhad (PNB). ASNB serves as the unit trust management company of PNB, which is one of the largest fund management firms in Malaysia. ASNB, which was founded in 1979, has played an essential role in offering Malaysian citizens access to a diverse range of investment prospects, primarily through the creation of its unit trust funds. There are over 2,700 agents' branches in Malaysia, in addition to 33 branches located throughout the country.

ASNB was founded through the formation of Yayasan Pelaburan Bumiputera (YPB). YPB was founded on January 9, 1978. The primary goal of this institution is to guide and motivate Malaysian Bumiputera individuals in the corporate sector and capital market. This is in line with the New Economic Policy (NEP). Permodalan Nasional Berhad (PNB) was founded on 17 March 1978 as a financial institution and fund management firm. Its primary role is to develop investment strategies and select the most promising companies. ASNB was created on 22 May 1979 as a subsidiary of PNB with the responsibility of administering the unit trust. The primary objective of introducing the unit trust was to enhance the socio–economic standing of the Bumiputera community.
