CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

This chapter explain the background and rationale of this project. Thus, this chapter provides the project background, problem statement, research questions, objectives, scope, and significance of the project.

1.1 Background of Study

According (Syaikh, 2001) menstrual blood is a natural blood that comes out of the womb once a woman reaches the age of baligh. It is not because of the illness. This menstrual come it certain times unrelatedly of certain causes. The period of the menstrual period is six or seven days, while the longest duration is 15 days with the night or even less. Based on a book of Wanita Dambaan Syurga (Khasasi, 2014), Imam Ahmad mention the longest duration is 17 days. However, if a woman gets menstruation more than 15 days or less per day, then the condition is not considered as a period of menstruation. The blood that came out than the time mentioned, is the blood of istihadah, in which the woman is obliged to do as a muslim should do such as perform solat, recite al Quran, Hajj or Umrah.

The pattern of the purity duration is the remaining balance of days of menstruation within a month. Usually a woman will be having menstral once a month. If the menstruation comes for 6 or 7 days, then the period is 23 or 24 days (Khasasi, 2014). At least half of the two menstruation 15 days and 15 nights. And there are no borders (Qadir, Tuskan & Al-Madani, 2012). Based on the book *Fatwa-Fatwa Tentang Wanita* (Syaikh, 2001) according to the scholar 'As-Syafie, clean from blood (al-niqa') during menstruation during menstrual periods it is considered as menopause provided that it does not exceed 15 days and not less than the minimum period of menstruation and net (breaks down blood) menstrual blood.
