

PERINTAH KAWALAN PERGERAKAN

Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan merupakan satu perintah yang menghadkan pergerakkan rakyat pada ketika ianya dikuatkuasakan bermula 18 Mac 2020 di seluruh Malaysia. Pada tanggal 18 Mac 2020, semua pelajar telah diarahkan oleh pihak Kementerian Pengajian Tinggi untuk terus kekal berada di universiti sehingga Mei 2020. The speaker is Associate Professor Dr Leong Siow Hoo, a data scientist who has more than fifteen years of experience in data processing, analyzing, and interpreting. There was a total participation of 37 lecturers from UiTM Sarawak Branch, Mukah Campus. This webinar aims to expose the lecturers to Big Data which can help facilitate their research activities and database management in the future. According to

IBM, big data is a term applied to data sets whose size or type is beyond the ability of traditional relational databases to capture, manage and process the data with low latency. The objectives of the webinar were to explore the introduction to big data for research and publication and discuss ways to better handle the big data systematically. It is hoped that after the webinar, the participants would be able to handle their research activities and database management well with the knowledge that they had gained from the webinar.
