he Invention, Innovation & Design Expo (SIIDEx) 2019 held at the CIDB Convention Centre Kuching on 21st to 23rd October 2019 was a collaboration between UiTM Sarawak, Sarawak Education Department (JPNS) and Sarawak Multimedia Authority (SMA). SIIDEx was organised as a natural platform to promote and nurture interest in Science and Technology amongst school students in Sarawak. A total of 128 products competed in SIIDEx 2019, under four different categories. These products were judged based on their originality, creativity, functionality, commercial potential and quality of presentation.
