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Spring Book Stopper

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Abstract

The spring book stopper is design to assist users and library staff in retrieving and reshelving books from the shelf. Common problems that exist pertaining to library book shelves is that books arrangements are usually not in order due to continuous retrieval and shelving by users thus creating a gap between books on the shelf. Such gap exist because the book divider is not intact to the shelf and could easily be misplaced or moved from its intended position thus reflects the arrangement of books on that shelf. Based on the design, it will be easy for users to browse and use the books from the shelf as the book divider or stopper works automatically to close these gaps. An improvement to the existing book divider where a movable book divider is built into the existing shelf unit. Its design considers elements of flexibility that benefits both library users and library staffs
