ACC117 ACADEMIC TALK ENHANCES FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING COMPETENCY

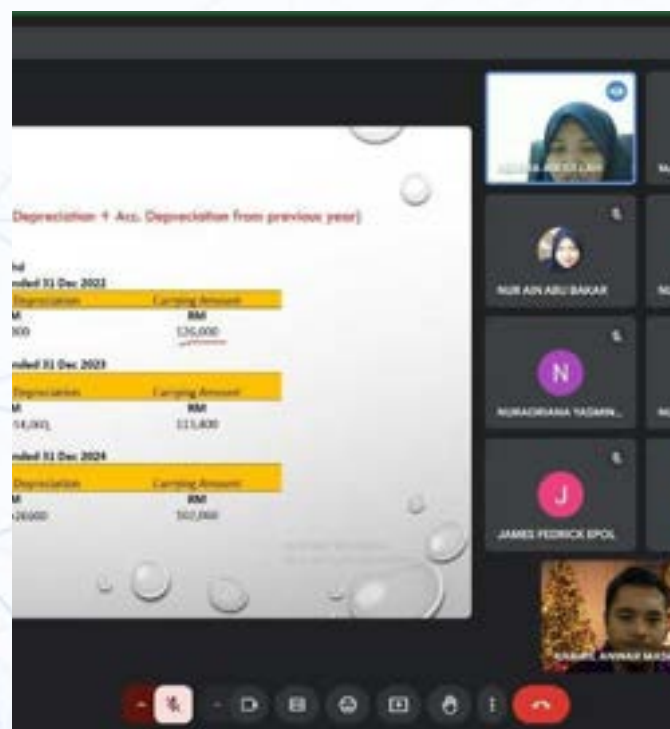
The Faculty of Accountancy successfully hosted an online academic talk titled “Financial Statement Preparation” for students enrolled in ACC117: Introduction to Financial Accounting and Reporting. The webinar was held on 13th January 2025 from 7:30 pm to 9:30 pm via Google Meet. The two-hour session drew the participation of 250 students eager to deepen their understanding of financial statement construction.

The talk, led by Puan Azmira Binti Abdullah, an experienced accounting lecturer from UiTM Sarawak Branch, Samarahan Campus, aimed to strengthen students’ grasp of the systematic process of preparing accurate and complete financial statements. The presentation covered the structure and essential components of the Income Statement and Balance Sheet, along with a detailed, step-by-step preparation guide.

Participants were also guided through common mistakes to avoid, and the session was enriched with live examples and exam-style questions. A dedicated Q&A segment allowed students to clarify misconceptions and engage directly with the speaker.

Student feedback was overwhelmingly positive, with many expressing increased confidence and a clearer understanding of the course material. The session proved to be a timely academic support initiative ahead of final assessments, effectively reinforcing key course content and application.
