embers of Diploma in Accountancy (MeDIA) organised an Inter-Programme Accounting Challenge on 4 May and 12 May 2018 at UiTM Sarawak Samarahan 2 campus. The main purpose of this competition was to give students the opportunity to build their analytical skills and competency level in accounting. Most students tend to regard accounting as a difficult subject and fail to see its relevance. In addition, it allows students to apply theories and knowledge of accounting in real competitive situations.

The participants, who were taking Introductory Accounting subject, were from Diploma in Accountancy (AC110), Diploma in Public Administration (AM110), Diploma in Computer Science (CS110) and Diploma in Office Management and Technology (BM118). The preliminary round was conducted on 4 May 2018 at Dewan Kuliah 4 while the final round was conducted on 12 May 2018 at FSG Auditorium (Blok B). Ten teams took part in the preliminary round with the top four teams successfully qualifying for the final round. A few lecturers from the Faculty of Accountancy were involved as question setters and judges.

AC110 won the first place followed by CS110 and AM110 as the first runner up and the second runner up respectively. All the top three teams received cash prizes, plaques and certificates of participation. Miss Dayang Nazari Awang Drahman, *Ketua Pusat Pengajian* from the Faculty of Accountancy, officiated the closing ceremony of the competition.
