

UiTM Sarawak Conference 2008 was a Success Written by Ng Kui Choo and Dr Nurhani Aba Ibrahim

As Malaysia joins the rest of the world in moving towards a knowledge-based economy, its main responsibility lies in the development of human capital to produce an adequate supply of intellectual and skilled workforce. UiTM as an institution of higher learning has an important role to play in providing the professional manpower to meet the human resource needs of the country. This was emphasised by YB Datin Fatimah Abdullah, Assistant Minister in the Chief Minister's Department during the launching of the UiTM Sarawak Conference at the university campus in Kota Samarahan on 2 December 2008.





Themed "Advancing towards International Standing", the two-day conference was attended by around 260 lecturers and heads of sections and units from the University branch campuses. There were 32 papers from both academic and non-academic tracks presented during the Conference. According to organising chairman Dr. Song Saw Imm, the main objective of the Conference was to discuss issues related to the development of the university and to determine the strategies needed for the university to achieve world class excellence.

UiTM Sarawak Director, Associate Professor Dr Jamil Haji Hamali, reiterated that the Conference served as a platform to study problems and issues faced by the different departments in UiTM Sarawak. "Identifying the problems faced by each and every department will enable us to find solutions and discover strategies to help us solve the different problems encountered," he said.

A number of resolutions pertaining to Staff Development, Student Development, Institutional Development, Maintenance and Facility Enhancement were drawn up and presented during the second day.



Professor Dr Mohamad Kamal Haji Harun, Deputy Vice Chancellor of UiTM Malaysia, officiated the closing ceremony and congratulated UiTM Sarawak for taking the initiative to organise the Conference in line with the University's aspiration to attain world-class status. He added that UiTM has always encouraged research among its academic staff and that UiTM has obtained various awards locally and internationally in researches and innovations and this is proof of its world-class standards.
