The index is 13 per cent up last Friday compared with the resolution of the debt ceiling crisis that had given the market a boost after the White House and US congressional leaders reached a deal to increase the ceiling on May 31.

On a Friday on Friday, the FBM KLCI gained 21.72 points to end last week at 4,281.28 points from the previous week's 4,259.56.

USIP University Malaysia assistant professor of finance, Dr Lim Chai Yikang said a cash FBM KLCI rebound was possible, albeit for a short term.

Elaun latihan industri wajar disemak semula

SHAH ALAM - Pembayaran elaun latihan industri kepada mahasiswa perlu disemak semula dan diselarasakan mengikut kesesuaian.

Ketua Program Komunikasi Media Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM), Dr. Hasrul Hashim berkata, surat edaran Jabatan Perkhidmatan Awam (JPA) pada 6 September 2019 menjelaskan mahasiswa yang menjalankan latihan industri sepatutnya perlu dibayar RM5 untuk setiap satu jam.

"Nilai bayaran mengikut waktu kerja iaitu lapan jam sehari, jika dikira semula dengan jumlah bekerja membolehkan seorang mahasiswa mendapat sekurang-kurangnya RM1,200 sebulan.

"Jadi, dalam erti kata lain penindasan berlaku apabila sebuah syarikat tidak membayar atau jumlah elaun yang rendah kepada mahasiswa," katanya ketika dihubungi *Sinar Harian* pada Isnin.

Sementara itu, Pensyarah Kanan Fakulti Pengurusan dan Perniagaan (Sumber Manusia) Universiti Teknologi

MARA (UiTM), Dr. Muhammad Aiman Arifin berkata, isu berkaitan elaun latihan industri bukanlah perkara baharu namun ia masih belum menemui jalan penyelesaian.

Menurutnya, majikan perlu menyediakan elaun sewajarnya atau memperkasa inisiatif dalaman yang merangkumi aspek makanan dan pengangkutan.

"Sebagai contoh majikan boleh menyediakan kupon makanan dua kali sehari serta memberi elaun pengangkutan kerana sedikit sebanyak ia dapat mengurangkan kos perbelanjaan harian mereka," ujar beliau.

Tambahnya lagi, pihak kerajaan perlu membuat keputusan untuk menyalurkan jumlah sebenar pembayaran elaun kerana terdapat perbezaan syarikat di bawah kerajaan dan swasta.

"Agensi kerajaan kebiasaannya tidak bayar elaun atau ben dalam jumlah yang sedikit sahaja, berbeza dengan syarikat swasta antara RM500 hingga RM1,500 sebulan," katanya.
