In a move to empower the local community and foster entrepreneurship, the Faculty of Pharmacy, Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM), Puncak Alam Campus, successfully hosted the *Bengkel Pembuatan Produk Hiliran Berasaskan Madu Kelulut*'. The collaborative event, held on 24 September 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Pharmaceutics Lab, brought together military families for a day of innovation and skill-building.





This workshop is a key initiative under the 'Pembangunan Komuniti Tertumpu di Kem ATM, Projek Madu Kelulut di Kem MOSEP' grant. It is designed to enhance community skills, promote self-reliance, and unlock sustainable income opportunities by leveraging local natural resources.

Throughout the day, eight members of *Badan Kebajikan Keluarga Angkatan Tentera* (*BAKAT*) from the MOSEP were guided by eight expert faculty members. Participants explored the potential of madu kelulut (stingless bee honey), learning how to transform it into high-value downstream products such as therapeutic soaps and nourishing body scrubs. The programme featured both theoretical lessons and a hands-on session, during which attendees crafted their own products.
