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## **1.1 INTRODUCTION**

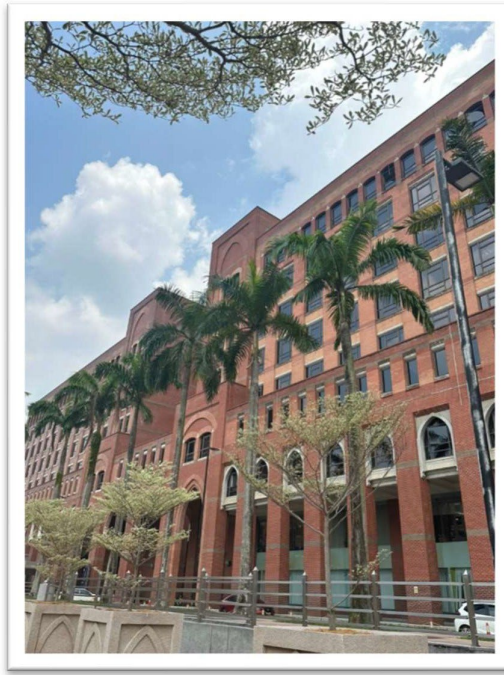


Figure 1.1: Kementerian Sumber Manusia (KSM)
