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# Knowledge Sharing Programme with Majlis Profesor Negara at Lundu and Sematan

The Knowledge Sharing programme with school students was implemented in Lundu and Sematan from 28 to 29 January 2016. This programme was under *Majlis Profesor Negara* for ICT Cluster headed by Yang Berbahagia Prof. Datuk Dr. Khairuddin Ab. Hamid and a team of professors from UTEM, Yang Berbahagia Prof. Dr. Ahmad Zaki b. Abu Bakar and Prof. Dr. Rabiah bt Ahmad and Yang Berbahagia Prof. Dato' Dr. Teo Kok Seong from UKM. They were assisted by academicians, Prof. Dr. Narayanan from UNIMAS and Dr. Nadrawina Isnin and Madam Noorfadhleen Mahmud from the Faculty of Administrative Science and Policy Studies, UiTM Sarawak.

The two-day programme was designed in such a way that the big groups of students were divided into two small groups. At SMK Lundu, the group comprised 300 students from Form 4 and Form 2 respectively while at SMK Sematan, the target groups were Form 1A with 32 students and Form 5 with 218 students.

The lectures were presented by Prof. Khairuddin Ab. Hamid and Prof. Dr. Ahmad Zaki b. Abu Bakar who spoke on the opportunities of furthering their studies in the public universities and Technical and Vocational Training (TVET) institutions. Prof. Nara spoke on ICT and work opportunities in ICT. Besides academic lectures, there were also talks by practitioners from the Malaysia Multimedia and Communication Commissioner (SKKM), an automobile entrepreneur, a mural artist, 1M4U and the Fire Brigade.

In between the lectures, both Madam Noorfadhleen and Dr. Nadrawina Isnin volunteered to assist Prof. Rabiah, the Head of the research team. 30 respondents from each school were selected for focus group interview sessions. A report by Prof. Rabiah and Dr. Nadrawina Isnin was handed to Prof. Ahmad Zaki at the end of the day.


Finally, there were gift presentations by respective schools and presenters before the photo sessions. It was a new experience for the participants since it was the first time that they were
