

# MOU WITH Islamic Azad University, Iran (2023)

On November 29, 2023, UITM and Islamic Azad University Isfahan held an online meeting to introduce researchers and share research interests in water and environmental studies. Participants from Iran included experts in sustainable agriculture, irrigation, environmental sciences, and water engineering. From Malaysia, researchers from various engineering disciplines, including water quality, industrial wastewater, and solar energy, participated.

This meeting aimed to establish a foundation for future collaborative research projects, focusing on pressing environmental issues and innovative solutions.

## with D8 International University (2023-2024)

The College of Engineering and D8 International University (D8IU) of Iran convened an online meeting in November 2023 to introduce researchers and discuss areas of interest, particularly in water and environmental studies.
