This annual sporting event aimed to cultivate a healthy and holistic campus environment by promoting physical fitness, skill development, and meaningful community engagement. It also served as a valuable platform for identifying and nurturing promising athletes to represent UCS at higher level competitions, particularly UiTM Student Sports Carnival (KARISMA), while fostering sportsmanship and strengthening bonds among students across faculties. The programme unfolded in two well-organised phases. Phase I, held on 6–7 December 2025, featured inter-faculty team sports, followed by Phase II on 13–14 December 2025, which focused on individual sporting events. The matches were conducted at the UCS Sports Courts. Throughout both phases, matches were carried out in a spirited, competitive, and sportsmanlike environment, fostering unity and healthy rivalry among students from various faculties.

The programme concluded with the official closing ceremony at Dewan Berlian on 14 December 2025.
