UiTMLaw embarked on a review of the Bachelor of Legal Studies (Hon) (LW213) CURRICULUM. The review aimed to align the program with the MQA Law and Shariah Program Standard, as well as with the MQA 2.0 and the Ministry of Higher Education's Program Learning Outcomes. The curriculum review has incorporated the current knowledge and skills needed for law graduates. New elective courses are introduced, including artificial intelligence and law, competition law, energy law and halal-related laws. The weight and contents of core courses are also updated. “Profesion Peguam Syarie: Pengamalan di Malaysia”, 7 September 2019

During the briefing to the new DLSA students on Saturday, 7 September 2019 at the Auditorium, Bangunan Pentadbiran Cempaka, the Faculty of Law invited Yang Arif Zulfikri bin Yasoa ; the Selangor Syariah High Court Judge to deliver a talk entitled ***“Profesion Peguam Syarie: Pengamalan di Malaysia”*** which was the main focus of the program.
