# The Majlis Sanjungan Budi & Apresiasi, The Staff Excellence Awards 2019 & Independence Month Celebration

On 27 August 2020, the Quality Management Unit of the Faculty of Law, Universiti Teknologi MARA had the honour of organising three significant events during a luncheon at the Grand Ballroom, Hotel Concorde, Shah Alam. The first session of the programme, Majlis Sanjungan Budi & Apresiasi, began with the Dean of Faculty of Law's welcoming speech. In her speech, Assoc Prof Dr Hartini Saripan indicated that the purpose of the ceremony was to celebrate and appreciate the contributions of retired academics and administrative staff who transferred to other departments and campus. This session celebrated the retirement of Prof Dato' Dr Rahmat Mohamad, Assoc Prof Dr Normawati Hashim and Assoc Prof Datin Dr Musrifah Sapardi in 2020. The retirees delivered their speeches before the souvenirs were presented to them. The ceremony was also graced by a cake cutting ceremony to close the first session. Their friendship and scholarly contributions will be missed as they were actively involved in research, publications, teaching, learning and administration of the Faculty of Law.

The second session, the Staff Excellence Awards Ceremony 2019, was the highlight of the ceremony. This event was held to celebrate the achievements and dedication of Faculty members. 105 awards were conferred to 97 academicians and to 9 administrative staff. The 97 awards presented were 56 Publications Awards, 17 Research Awards, 10 Industry/ Collaboration Partners Awards, 6 Supervision Awards, 1 Innovation Award and 9 Students' Choice Awards. Heartiest congratulations to the recipients of the awards. The ceremony was also interspersed with performances from academics and administrative staff, as well as a specially invited singer to enliven the programme.

As the programme was only a few days ahead of the National Day on August 31, the third and the last session of the programme celebrated the Independence Day of Malaysia in 1957. The session began with a poetry recital on the Independence by Puan Nurulhuda Adabiah Mustafa and Puan Hamizah Abdul Aziz. Later, led by Encik Mohd Yunus Abu Samah, the attendees recited the Rukun Negara pledge as a symbol of allegiance to the country. The ceremony concluded with the singing of several patriotic songs to further strengthen the spirit of respect and unity amongst Malaysians.
