# FRGS 2026 GRANT PROPOSAL PREPARATION WORKSHOP



The Faculty of Civil Engineering (FCE), UiTM Shah Alam, organised an intensive two-day workshop on 6-7 November 2025 to strengthen the capability of lecturers and researchers in developing competitive research grant proposals. Through expert guidance and strategic sharing sessions, participants were exposed to effective methods for writing high-quality proposals, preparing budgets, and aligning research plans with national priorities.

## INDUSTRY ADVISORY PANEL (IAP) MEETING SESSION 2025



The Faculty of Civil Engineering, UiTM Shah Alam, held its Industry Advisory Panel (IAP) Meeting Session 2025 on Tuesday, 11 November 2025, at the Al-Jazari Room, Level 6. This full-day programme brought together the Faculty's Top Management, the OBE Committee, Quality Committee, Accreditation Committee, industry representatives, as well as Resource Persons (RP) and

Course Coordinators (CC). The meeting aimed to evaluate curriculum effectiveness, review the Programme Educational Objectives (PEO) and Programme Outcomes (PO) for engineering programmes, assess course documentation, and strengthen CQI elements to ensure alignment with industry expectations, professional bodies, and EAC/ETAC accreditation standards. In addition, discussions included improvements to key courses such as Industrial Training (IT), Integrated Design Project (IDP), Final Year Project (FYP), and Work-Based Learning (WBL) to ensure more robust and relevant programme delivery. A concluding session was held to summarise and outline enhancement proposals to be implemented in the next academic cycle. The programme successfully achieved its objectives through strong collaboration between academia and industry, towards producing competent, professional engineering graduates who meet current market needs.
