The objective of this knowledge transfer program is to enhance community development to schools, teachers, students, the Orang Asli community.

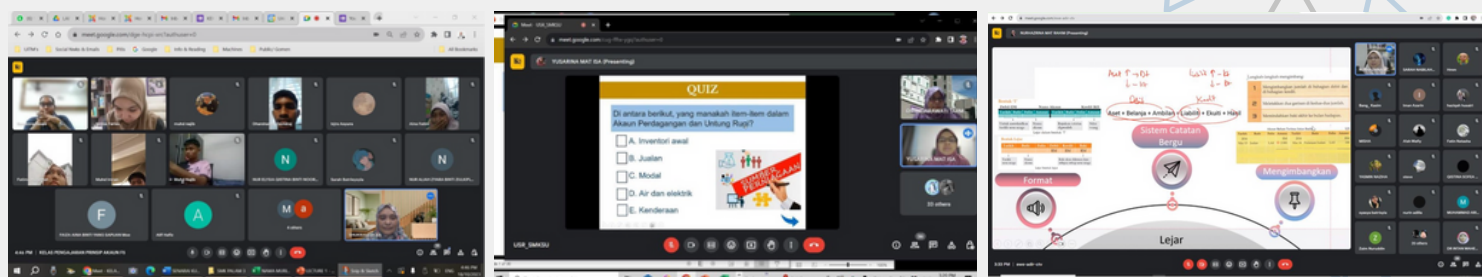
