The Faculty of Pharmacy successfully conducted a series of Objective Structured Clinical Examinations (OSCE) and viva assessments for our third- and final-year Bachelor of Pharmacy students, marking another important milestone in ensuring competency-based pharmacy education.

The assessment commenced on 23 June 2026 with the course PHC635 (Introduction to Clinical Pharmacy) for Part 6 students, providing them with the opportunity to demonstrate their foundational clinical and communication skills in simulated practice settings.

The assessments continued for our final-year students on 25 June 2026 with the course PHC690 (Applied Therapeutics in Neurological, Immunological, Musculoskeletal and Psychiatric Disorders) and PHC691 (Applied Therapeutics in Gastrointestinal, Renal and Endocrine Disorders). The OSCE series concluded on 26 June 2026 with the viva assessment for PHC692 (Applied Therapeutics in Cardiovascular and Pulmonary Disorders), where students showcased their clinical reasoning, therapeutic decision-making, and professional competence.
