3.1 BACKGROUND

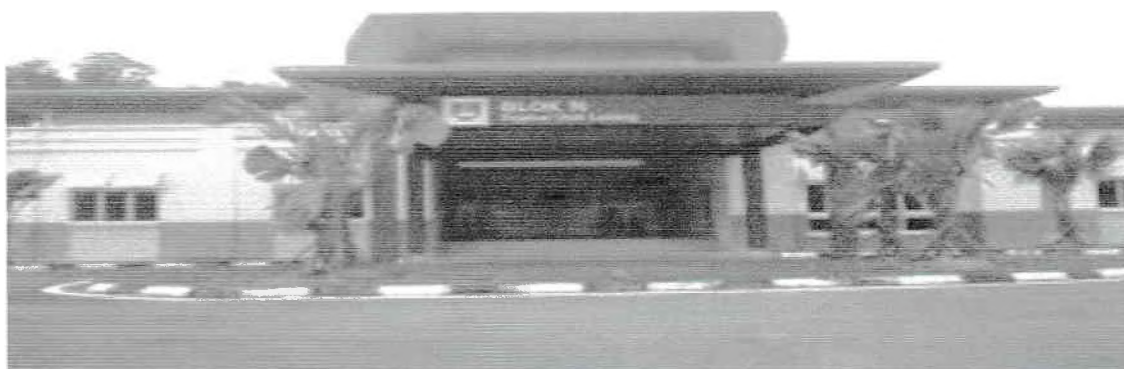


FIGURE 1:UNIT LADANG UITM KAMPUS SAMARAHAN
