Introduction

INTRODUCTION TO DARO JAYA TIASA PLANTATION



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Jaya Tiasa Holdings Berhad is the leading fully integrated timber producer in Malaysia with access to 1.76 million acres of timber concessions in the state of Sarawak, Malaysia. Jaya Tiasa is derived from 2 Bahasa Malaysia words Jaya Sentiasa which means 'Success always'.

Then, Daro Jaya Tiasa Plantation is one of the oil palm company in state of Sarawak. There are 4 phases in this plantation company and I have practical at phase 4 which consist of 3 phase, phase 4A, phase 4B and phase 4C. The total area for phase 4 is 2335.46 Ha and there is a division between all of the 3 phases. For phase 4A, the area is consists of 830.61 Ha altogether while for phase 4B and 4C, the area are consist of 916.48 Ha and 613.43 Ha respectively.

Daro Jaya Tiasa Plantation phase 4 have been started on the October 2009 and the last year of planting is January 2012. There are 8 types of materials that have been planted in phase 4 which are Guthrie, United Plantation (UP), Sawit Kinabalu, Felda, Applied Agriculture Resources (AAR), Sime Darby, Golden Hope (G.Hope) and HRU. The standard per hectare (SPH) of planting oil palm is 152 palms per hectare where the distance between palms is 8.7m x 8.7m.
