1.1: INTRODUCTION

1.2: Location Details

Location of Internship Program

- The location of my Internship Program is at Solid Oil Palm Plantation Sdn Bhd (SQPPSB), Bakun. There are two of us being placed at the estate and both of us are from UiTM Sarawak that taken Diploma of Plantation Industry Management program. We have been thought about various new knowledge about the organization and their activity at the estate such as management of their system, harvesting process in the estate, maintenance program, application of fertilizer, loose fruit collection, fresh fruit bunches (FFB), estate accounts and more.
