This study aims to examine the factors affecting Crime Rate in 5 selected countries in South East Asia from 2007 until 2017. The countries consists of Malaysia, Vietnam, Thailand, Indonesia, and Singapore. This study would like to investigate the significant relationship between Crime Rate (CR) as dependent variable with all the independent variables namely Income Inequality (GINI), Inflation (CPI), and Population Rate (PR) as well as Unemployment Rate (UR).
