CHAPTER 1

1.1 Introduction

Islam (رالإسلام), al-islām), the youngest of the great religions is the world's second largest and arguably the fastest growing religion in the world. The word of 'Islam' can be defined as obedience or submission to God. (Mawdudi, 1980; Fowler, Gerber, Lawrence, 2000).¹ It is a monotheistic faith which refers believing the God (شا, Allāh) and one of the Abrahamic religions. Islam is a religion which guided by Prophet Muhammad who was the founder of Islam. Therefore, an adherent of Islam is called as 'Muslim'.

There are other world major religions such as Christianity, Baha'i, Buddhism, Confucianism, Hinduism, Jainism, Judaism, Shinto, Sikhism, Taoism, and Zoroastrianism.
