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ABSTRACT

The law of torts, through the use of the Neighbour principle and the Foo Fiona's Test has been the only control device for medical negligence cases in Malaysia up until now. Medical negligence which governed by civil system is somehow unable to restrain cases of negligence by medical practitioners from arising day by day. The existence of this standard of care however does not seem to constantly put medical practitioner on the standard required.
