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THE MODERATING EFFECT OF INNOVATION CAPABILITY ON THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN CORPORATE ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND ORGANIZATIONAL PERFORMANCE OFSMES IN LOGISTICS INDUSTRY IN MALAYSIA

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Abstract

Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) has been an integral part to the Malaysia's economic transformation process. This transformation process is linked with the performance of SMEs. Performance of the SMEs can be viewed from the corporate entrepreneurship (CE) perspectives and the innovation capability (IC) as the moderating factor driving SME performance.
