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ABSTRACT

Sign language is a gesture used by mute and deaf people to communicate with each other and normal people. However, platforms or learning material for normal people to learn sign language to understand mute and deaf people are limited since most of the platforms to learn have to pay and not everyone can afford the fee. Therefore, E-learning Sign Language Using Storytelling for Malaysian (ESL) is created so that it can be accessed by anyone and people do not have to pay to learn and provide more contents about sign language.
