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## INTRODUCTION

### COMPANY BACKGROUND

Public Works Department (PWD) or Jabatan Kerja Raya (JKR) was established in 1872 with Major J.F.A McNair as the first head of the organization. The so-called Pangkor Treaty (1874) paved the way for British influence in Malay States. During this year, they managed to make inroad into Perak, Selangor and Negeri Sembilan. They posted their Residents and Subordinate Officers to advise the Malay rulers. Later, Pahang also accepted this residential system of government. In 1896, the system was administrated centrally with Kuala Lumpur as the seat of authority.

Public Works Department (PWD) or (Jabatan Kerja Raya) Tanah Merah was created in 1949. It is located on an area of approximately 0.4047 hectares at Kampung Banggol, Jalan Jedok, about 1.8 km from the Centre of Tanah Merah. The original Office built in 1949 and was upgraded to current building in 1976.

At the beginning of the creation, PWD Tanah Merah placed under the control of Kota Bharu Kelantan. Shortly thereafter, it was placed under the JKR South Kelantan based in Machang. Once again the PWD Tanah Merah under PWD Kelantan West based in Pasir Mas until it became a full Province including the Provincial PWD Jeli in 1978 and administered by a Colonial Engineer who is assisted by an Assistant Engineers tasked with projects in the province before the establishment of the PWD Colony Jeli in 1 January 1996.

In year 2012, a new office of JKR Tanah Merah was complete after doing the refurbishment and moved in on February 2012. For this department there are 60 workers.

PWD Tanah Merah has the objective and functions of the responsible to JKR Kelantan. To ensure productivity and quality has been determined to achieve it has been divided into 8 sections, namely:-
