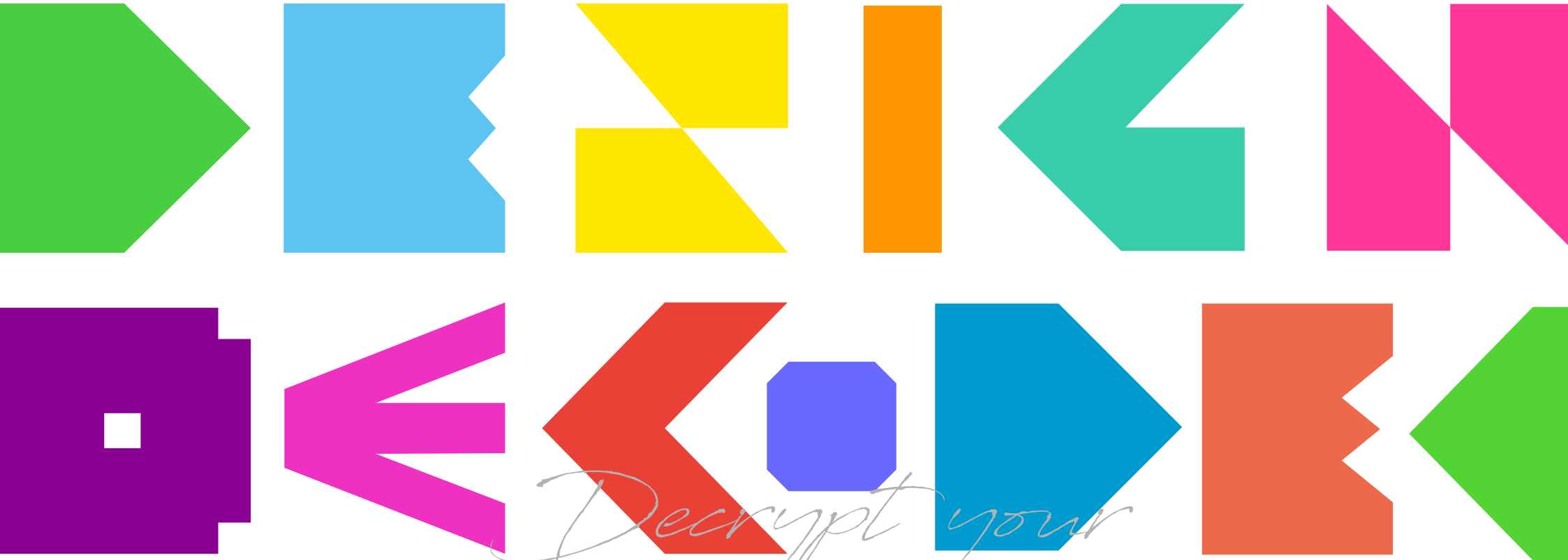

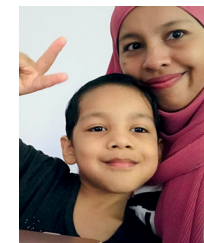

Orange is the color that represents creativity, adventure, with the combination of yellow and red. orange synonyms with Ahmad little brother element of vibrancy and fun. Orange is also a friendly color that also stimulates action

so, like red, it is an accent color to catch the eye and promote activity. Meanwhile purple represents Ahmad's color. Purple is for mystery and spirituality. It is warm and cool and combines the passion and energy of red with the calm and serenity of blue. Green is for growth and harmony, the color of stability. That is the color of Ahmad's father.
