At least 700 million individuals are expected to suffer from debilitating hearing loss and require ear and hearing care. Damage to the inner ear is one of the most common causes of hearing loss, and some people are born deaf.

Thus, in New Product Development (NPD), we came out with a solution to produce a sign language app called Signtastic. We think that knowing sign language assists you to communicate with those who are deaf, hard of hearing, or deaf individuals. People in the community will find it simpler to communicate with a deaf person using Signtastic. This application also enables users to learn the whole range of sign language, including alphabets, facial emotions, and body postures. We may use this software to handle issues like miscommunication and misunderstanding that might arise between hearing and deaf persons. There is so much uniqueness in this software that it even includes a scanning capability that allows it to precisely recognise images and deliver sign language translation. Signtastic is a programme that translates English texts into sign language. This software includes a variety of sign languages, such as British Sign Language (BSL), American Sign Language (ASL), Malaysian Sign Language (MSL), and others. As a result, users may utilise Signtastic to learn sign language specific to their respective nations or areas.

2.1 Details of the Product

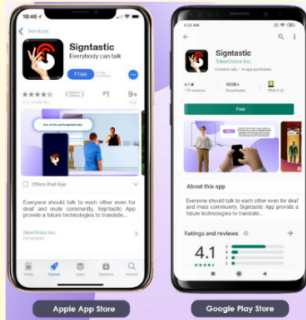
We introduced Signtastic, a sign language app that helps sign language learners, whether amateurs or experts, to sharpen the skill in no time. Our creation believes that being proficient in sign language allows users to communicate with hearing and speaking disabilities individuals. Not only it makes communicating a whole lot easier, but Signtastic also helps to promote better awareness and sensitivity to the deaf community. Miscommunication is a core problem as to why this app is developed in the first place, as roughly 90 to 95 of deaf children are born to hearing parents who in many cases do not have any basic knowledge of sign language and thus encounter problems before sending them to school. Moreover, cochlear implants are very costly, and most families cannot afford the surgery.

What makes our app different from other sign language apps is a scanning feature that allows it to identify text accurately and provide a real-time sign language translation, thanks to the Optical Character Recognition Software (OCR). Sign language can also be translated by using augmented reality (AR) technology to scan and recognize the gestures made, then translate it to the preferred language. Besides this application consists of various sign languages including British Sign Language (BSL), American Sign Language (ASL), Malaysian Sign Language (MSL), which is a trademark of Signtastic. Apart from that, Signtastic allows the users to learn the full extent of sign language, including the alphabets, facial expressions as well as hand gestures
