The interactive video presented by combining sounds and picture that will show a short story. This approached will act as an additional tool to assist respondents studying in Form 1 secondary school to improve their English vocabulary using interactive video. With the help from the interactive video, the student will be able to learn on their own with minimum assistance from the teacher. The school involved two states which are Kelantan and Selangor. 50 students of Form 1, was selected from two secondary schools. The pre-test, post-test, and t-test are the evaluation process to gather the feedback from the respondents. The limitations and directions for future development and research are discussed accordingly.

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
