

Go Global 2022: Webinar Series 1,2 & 3

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Go Global 2022 is a student mobility program co-organized by the Academy of Language Studies (APB), UiTM Negeri Sembilan and Universitas Pahlawan Tuanku Tambusai, Indonesia. It is a collaborative effort between the two universities which involves a total of 77 students and 25 lecturers from both universities in a series of webinars, online workshops, and presentations. Committees of the program consist of all APB lecturers at UiTM Kuala Pilah Campus and 11 lecturers from Universitas Pahlawan Tuanku Tambusai, Indonesia, who also act as program facilitators.

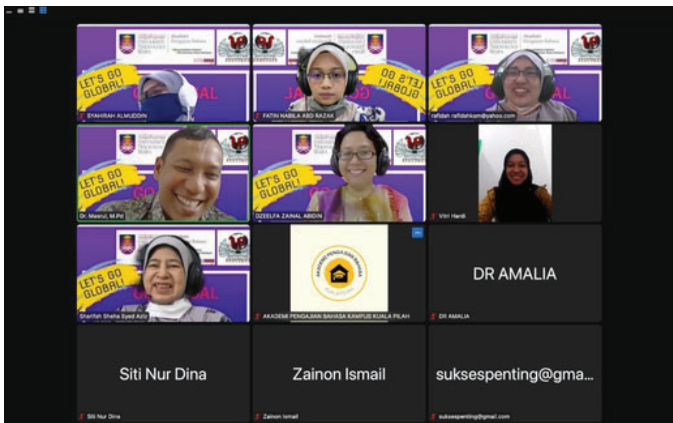
The main objective of Go Global 2022 is for students to exchange knowledge, ideas and experiences, and provide a platform for them to participate in a series of webinars, online discussions, and presentations. It is hoped that students can obtain useful knowledge – both academic and non-academic as well as skills to prepare them for future employment. As for the academic staff, the program provides an opportunity for them to contribute at the international level and benefits them in terms of career development.

In line with the *Go Global 2022* program, three (3) webinar series have been conducted in April and May 2022 and hosted by the Academy of Language Studies (APB), UiTM Negeri Sembilan, Kuala Pilah Campus. These webinars are part of the 6 webinar series which will be held throughout the year from April to November 2022.

The 1st webinar entitled Embracing Cultural Harmony was held on the 6th April 2022 and delivered by two guest speakers - Dr Sharifah Sheha, Head of Academy of Language Studies (APB), UiTM Negeri Sembilan and Dr Masrul from Universitas Pahlawan Tuanku Tambusai, Indonesia. Despite a number of similarities in terms of cultural aspects of both countries, many participants found that the webinar was interesting as many are still not aware of the historical backgrounds and other cultural differences of both countries.

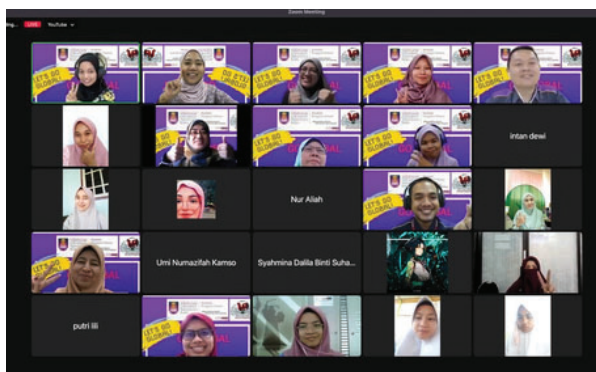

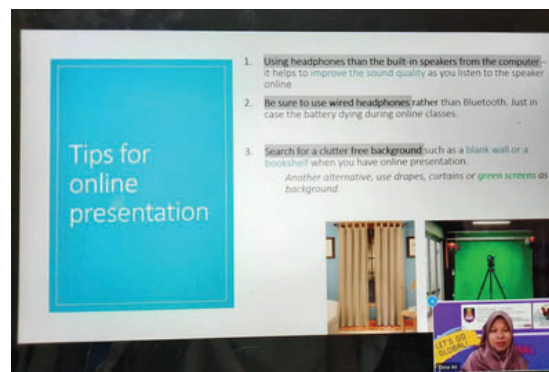

Each webinar lasted for one hour and followed by a specific task for the students' participants to complete within the allocated time frame. Response to the 3 webinar series was great and more than 100 participants attended each of the webinar which was conducted on two different platforms - Zoom & Youtube live.
