It being the policy of BSI to review structural design documents every 10 years, a further edition was published in 1959. It is worth noting that during that half century, the design rules had changed five times and had grown from five pages to upwards of 100 That metricated 1959 edition is still being used after 28 years, and thus a generation designers has come into being which knows no other in contrast to their forebears who were fairly regular and sometimes drastic changes ideas.

The development of the new document, now designated BS 5950, is itself an interesting, and in some ways a salutory lesson.
