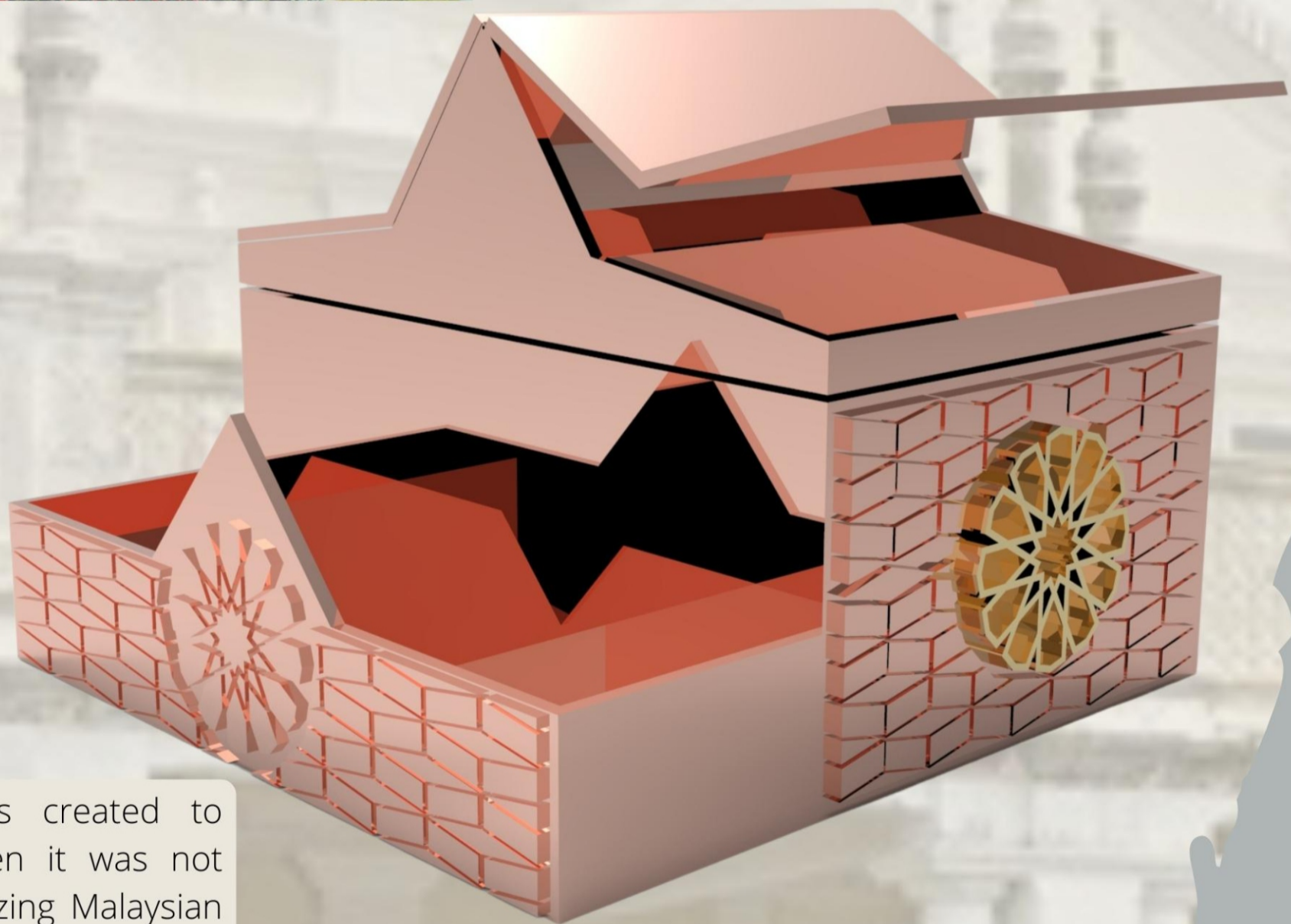


JEWELLERY BOX
