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## THE ABSTRACT

### Abstract

Today and onward, researchers are always trying to find out the relationship between the types of learning styles and student's performance in their studies by using GPA and CGPA as measurement tool. One of the famous learning styles theories is honey and mumford learning styles theory. This theory had been used by many researchers to find out the relationship between the learning styles and student's performance. And the results, there is a relationship between the two. The study examines the impact or effect of learning style on student' performance in UiTM Shah Alam based on the honey and mumford learning styles theory. The theory had four types of learning styles which is activists, pragmatics, theoristics, and reflectors. A convenience sample of 116 respondents from FSPPP and FTMSK students were participated in this research through 40 selected questions by Honey and Mumford. The first objective "To identify the significant differences of learning style among gender and faculties" were also examined. The second objective "To examine the learning style among FSPPP students and FTMSK students in UiTM Shah Alam" and "to identify the relationship between learning style and students' achievement" were also examined through this research. Based on the findings, most of FSPPP and FTMSK students are reflectors. Next, learning styles had no significant differences between gender and faculties. And the last finding is, learning styles are not the main factors to determine the level of student's performance. There are others factors that influence the level of student's performance in their study.
