ABSTRACT

Safe city refers to the idea in the community that uses technology to help the government and the community to reduce crime rates as well as create a safe and comfortable environment for the community. A safe city is also a livable environment in the context of sustainability where it is able to preserve the city for the quality of life of the community.
