## THE ABSTRACT

Bankruptcy is a legal status of a person or other entity that cannot repay the debts it owes to creditors. In most jurisdictions, bankruptcy is imposed by a court order, often initiated by the debtor. A person can be declared as a bankrupt if the debt owing is more than RM30, 000.00 and the creditor may file for bankruptcy action against the person through the court.
