An introduction to the basic concepts, exploration and techniques used in drawing. These concepts include, but are not limited to, linear perspective, figure/ground relationships, and composition. Students acquire skills in modeling forms and creating more expressive drawings using a variety of media. Through group critiques and individual instruction, students develop an understanding of drawing as a practice/process and begin building the foundation of a strong Research Work Book (RWB) |
