The Academy of Language Studies and Pre-Diploma Unit at UiTM Pulau Pinang Branch organized the 5th semester pre-diploma poster competition, Abracadabra 5.0, which took place from January 16th to 28th, 2023.

This program was open to pre-diploma students students who were taking ELC010 and ELC030 (English for Pre-Diploma) and served as a platform for them to apply and practice their English in a real and competitive context. The competition aimed to improve the students' communication skills and confidence level in English.

a. First place and best poster award were awarded to Azly Wafiy Bin Mohammad and team from group PBA0021B. Their poster titled 'The Peranakans' showcased the rich cultures of Peranakans found in Malaysia, particularly in Melaka and Penang.

b. Second place was accorded to Muhammad Hafizul Hakim Bin Khairul Anuar and his team from group PAS0071A. Their poster entitled 'Life on Land' highlighted the status quo of forests' biodiversity and preservation around the world.
