Located in Rumah Kanak-Kanak Taman Bakti, Kepala Batas, the Faculty of Hotel and Tourism Management (FPHP) UiTM Penang organized a community service on the 20th December 2018 from 9.00 am to 2.00 pm. The children's home is managed by Members and Chairman of the Board of Visitors appointed by YB. Women, Family and Community Development Minister in accordance with the Rules of the Child (Safe House) 2007. The duty includes to safeguard the welfare and interests of the children, to manage public donations and help to monitor the administration of the institution in the interests and welfare of the children (http://jkm.penang.gov.my)



There were several activities conducted that day including breakfast and luncheon, telematch, free milk- distribution to the children by Farm Fresh Sdn Bhd, coloring contest, cup cake decorating demonstration, dental and aedes booths fair and souvenir gift distribution to the children by SN Craft Ventures.



The opening cum closing ceremony was completed by the UiTM Penang Rector, Prof Madya Ts. Dr Mohd Hisbany Mohd Hashim.
